



Participant Application Instructions

Thank you for your interest in joining the Diverse Male Student Initiatives Program (DMSI).

There are easy steps for male students who are interested in joining the DMSI Program to take. These steps constitute the **DMSI Entrance Process** and they must be fulfilled. You will need to:

COMPLETED

1. **Complete both sides of the DMSI application.** It has 4 major sections:
 - Personal/Demographic Information
 - Academic/PGCC Information
 - Career/Personal Goals and Accomplishments
2. **Submit the application** to the DMSI Office (located in Bladen Hall, Room 122)
(if you obtain the DMSI application online, **you CANNOT submit it online.**) Print and bring the application to the DMSI Advisor in Bladen Hall, Room 122.
3. **Interview.** You will be personally contacted (via PGCC student email, phone or by text) for an interview. You will be expected to bring the following when you come for your interview and advising session:
 - A copy of your most recent PGCC Academic Program Evaluation
4. **Attend the “DMSI Blast-off”** as an initial “welcome/orientation” to the DMSI Program.
The DMSI Blast-Off is generally scheduled for the 2nd week of September.
5. **Attend the “Interest Session”** which serves as the information session to the DMSI Program.
These sessions are generally scheduled the 3rd week of September.

Entrance into the DMSI Program occurs in the **beginning of the Fall Semesters only**. If you become aware of the DMSI Program after the “Blast-Off” or the Interest Sessions which are held in September, please complete and submit your application anyway. Although you will not be considered as a DMSI member for that year, there are occasions when DMSI will invite those men who show an interest in joining DMSI to certain events. Also, all DMSI men who submit an application will have the benefit of receiving personal academic advising services throughout the year. It is as easy as setting up an appointment. No wait... No hassle.
